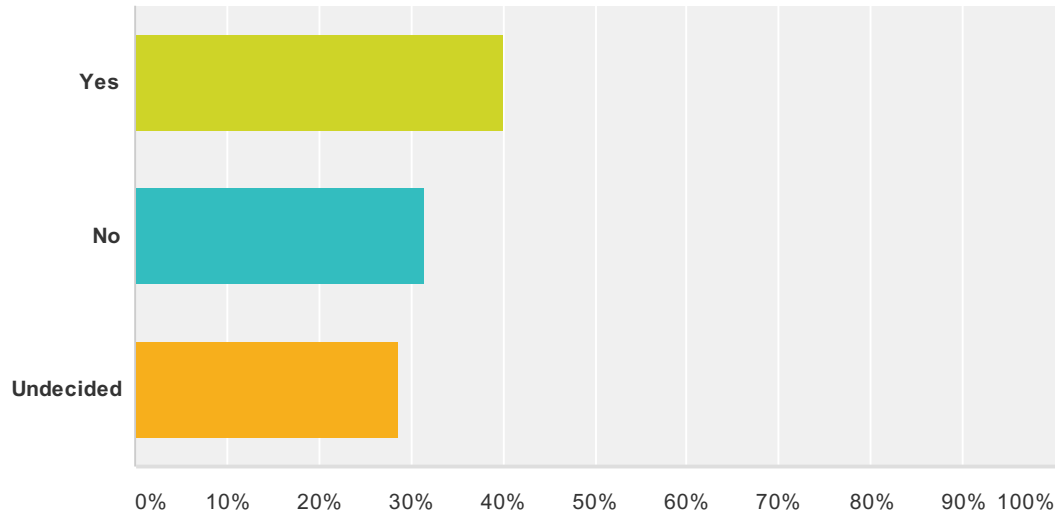


Mosquito Spraying in Pawnee City

Answered: 35 Skipped: 0

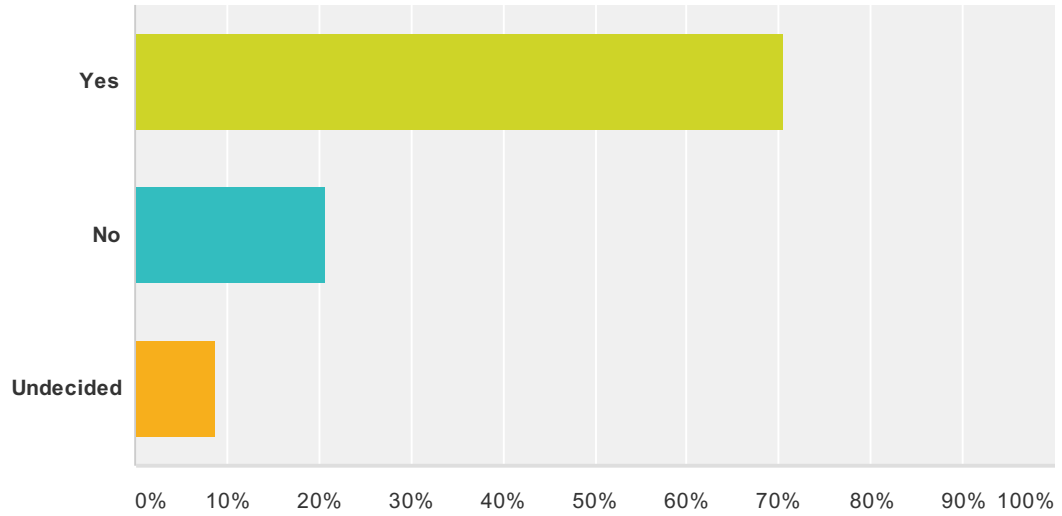

Answered: 34 Skipped: 1

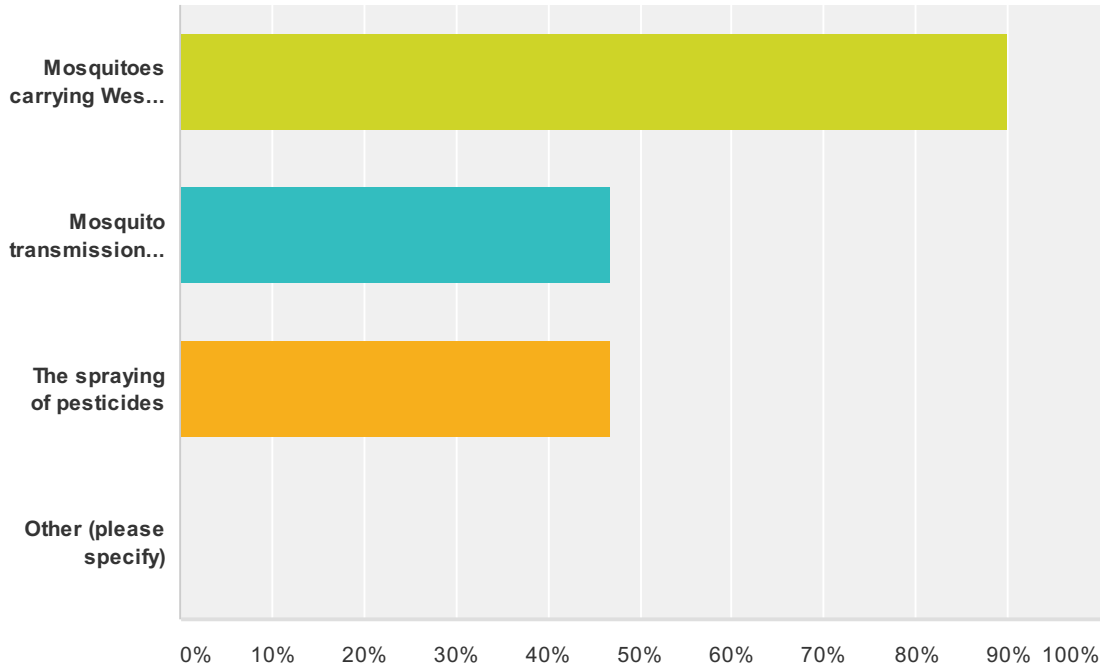

Answered: 30 Skipped: 5

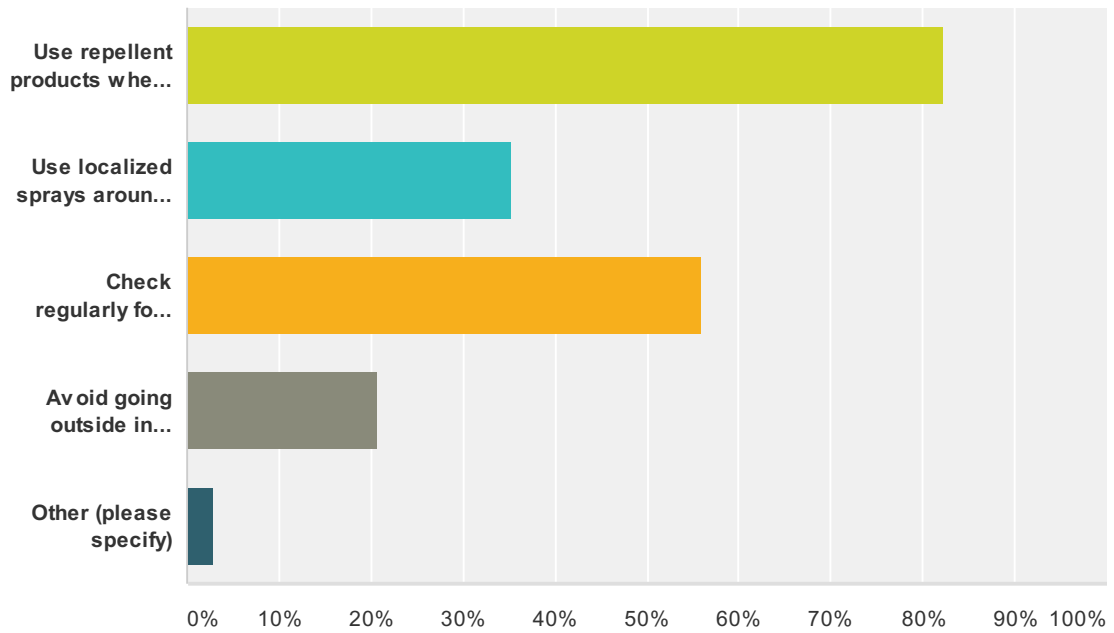
