

Snow And Ice Removal Plan

The City Foreman will drive the streets and assess the situation to see if the person on call or other employees need to be notified to either spread sand or remove snow. The employee on call will show up to clean and or salt the front walk at the office by 7 am on the days that the city office is open. If it is icy or slick the person on call will salt all of the sidewalks that the city is responsible for. If the foreman is not available the person on call will make the judgment call and can also contact the council member in charge of streets.

One employee will start uptown and the others will start with the Emergency Snow Route and Priority areas first. Priority areas start with uptown, 6th street from I to F street starting at hospital drive, F street (highway) from 6th to 12th street, 12th street from F street to C street(from highway past Manor & Assisted Living). **This is also our Emergency Snow Route.** Then when that is complete or another employee is available, the employees are to clean at 2 inches of snow the Fire Hall, City Parking Lot (Monday-Friday), Dr. Voigtlander's Alley (Between G & F St and 9th & 10th St), School road(Monday-Friday). If we have rain on top of snow that creates a layer of ice we need to plow as soon as possible.

Once the Priorities are done and if there is more than 3 inches of snow we will begin plowing residential streets. One employee will start on G Street and the others will start 8th street and work north 9, 10, 11, until you get to 17th street. The north, south streets will be worked in as you go north on the numbered streets. You will go from one end of the street to the other end as far as you can or until you have to turn around. Do not turn around anymore than you have to. You will make as many rounds on a street as needed to push the snow out as far off the street as possible.

Sanding up town needs to start at 6 am to get uptown done before the major traffic starts. Don't forget the library parking lot needs to be plowed and sanded before 7:30am at the latest. A second employee can be used to help watch for traffic if the employee feels it is necessary. Snow removal will start early enough to get the streets clean by the time the major traffic starts. We will not push snow if there is less than 3 inches on the residential streets.
